Four and one-half years ago, I pressed my physician to give me his best guess as to the outlook for my emphysema. In the discussion, he told me that, in four years, I would probably have great difficulty walking a flight of stairs even with oxygen.

Since that time I have had a kidney removed, received radiation treatment for prostate cancer, broke a few ribs, broke my wrist, and burst a vein in my right calf that resulted in a blood clot that kept me off the treadmill for four months.

Today, thanks to Endeavor Therapy, I can walk on a treadmill two and one-half miles an hour on a four-degree slope for thirty minutes. In addition to the treadmill, I am working out on a Cateye for ten minutes, a Nu Step for ten minutes, and a Recumbent Bike for ten minutes; at the highest tension that I have ever been able to achieve. In addition to that, I am working at the highest level of weights on the Universal Gym that I have ever been able to do.

Prior to these workouts, I was able to golf only every second hole. Today I can golf eighteen straight holes.

I wish to thank you and your staff for the care, the skill, and the dedication for making all this possible. I strongly urge anyone with a similar condition to commit themselves to your program.
